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1. Extend Pace of play time or eliminate walking. One person walking, especially in flights 7 and 8, and having a bad day will force all in the group to play much faster to keep up with the group ahead. My preference is to make carts mandatory.

4. I would like to see 25 of our tournaments on Friday, not 33. For those of us who work, we miss most of the Friday tourney's as we prioritize the Member guest and then have to choose one of two more as that's all we can make.

We should have at least a small dedicated area with free balls for tournament members. Maybe a free or discounted drink. We're treated no different than the random public. 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Just want to reiterate my view that each flight should play the same tees and thus the same golf course (specifically for individual events) within that particular flight. And I'm speaking mainly for the flight I participate in (first flight). This was a discussion point earlier in the season, and did not materialize further, so that was good.

Also, I do think there should be at least one gross payout in every tournament, but I know some did not have that this season, including several team events. Depending on handicaps and team partnership handicaps, the competitive balance can be tough if it is all net, especially in the first flight.

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1. Pace of play - timeclock is good, but the 1st group out is penalized relative to everyone else. It seems that if our objective is to use pace of play to eliminate the "5 hour" round (pick you favorite number), then you can't have time between groups at finish be 5 minutes more than tee time interval. I'd say pick a goal - e.g., 4h 40 minutes... 218 on front, 222 on back or no later than 10 minutes behind the group in front of you - otherwise pace of play does nothing to prevent 5 hour rounds...

2. Social - maybe a weekly happy hour - thursday, turn on ESPN, watch 1st round of tournament thursday evening... couple it with a Major Pool - operate a pool for the majors

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Here's some suggestions

- 1) Flight 2 should be NET Only. 5-7 Handicap can't compete with 0-3 Handicap in Gross.
- 2) I would like to see more ISP and mostly on Saturday/Sunday.
- 3) I'm not sure about the need of the time clock. The pace is mostly good.
- 4) Important there is a safety issue with hole 2. Create an out-of-bound to the right of the fairway to prevent someone from getting hit on hole 4.

I know my game sucks, but I think that I consistently found myself at the back of the bus. I did not play that many events but recall with certainty being in the last group twice and within the last five groups several other times including last week and this week. The flight seeding needs a critical review.

Secondly, I am disappointed that so many ISP's are scheduled on Fridays. Not everyone is retired. I think I played in 3 Friday events and had to skip many more due to career obligations. Hoping next year will see a more balanced schedule.

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All flights must play from the same tees. By having mixed tees in the same flight, the players are not playing the same golf course. Adjusting strokes to have mixed tees in the same flight is unheard of. This needs to change.

Need to move some of our tournament dates so they do not fall on the same dates as PGA Majors. It never fails that Ramsey gives the mens club 2-3 tournaments on the same dates as the majors. There is a reason he does that, however it continues to happen every year.

Too many teams in the flights on team events most of the time. Also, first flight players are off early way to often.
